







	<p>ByDesign Science Lab Videos</p>	<p>Loma Linda University and EXSEED have partnering with the Pacific Union Conference to produce and house ByDesign Science Lab Videos to help Adventist teachers prepare for labs in the ByDesign Science series. There are about 1,000 labs in the 8 grades. 76 short videos throughout the grade levels were selected for the first batch. Others will be added in the future.</p> <p>All videos are housed through the LLU EXSEED Portal.
